


## Registration for Bosphorus 2026


Registration opens on the website of the Turkish Olympic Committee on February 2 for the 38th swim across the Bosphorus. Experience from previous year has shown that slots can sell out in a matter of minutes.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO IN ORDER TO BE GUARANTEED A REGISTRATION FOR THE SWIM:


In advance, best to do it now, create an account on the website (by clicking 'Sign up') on this [website](#) and Kindly save the login and password, which should come to your email as well.



2. Check that the login and password are working (section 'Sign In')



3. At the appointed time, in your personal account, in the "COMPETITION APPLICATION" section, it will be possible to register for the swim.



4. Prepare two credit cards, preferably from different banks. Make sure that you have the required amount on the account (with a margin of \$550), as well as that there are no restrictions on payment to other countries (call to your bank in advance and check this information).
5. Prepare your data well in advance. Just in case, put your passport next to it.
6. After the registration record appears in your personal account and the payment takes place, you can relax - the slot is in your hands.

If you are engaged with us on the program "I will swim the Bosphorus", the second stage of registration is ours. Below are the documents for the second stage, which need to be brought to our headquarters.

## FROM YOU

- Doctor's certificate
- An original, completed application form from the organizers (will appear in your personal account after registration) with the completed medical part in English
- One photo 3/4
- Passport copy / Emirates ID

## FROM US

- Sending documents to the organizers
- A letter from the coach and supporting documents with his/her qualifications
- Filling out the questionnaire from the school and the coach
- Preparation for the swim with professional coaches following a proven training program, travel packages, tips & tricks, swim navigation guidance, and full race support.
